REQUIREMENTS

- 18 years or older
- Interest in a career in restoration, environmental sciences, and/or non-profit organizations
- Relevant academic coursework
- Commitment of at least 20 10-hour weeks during the academic year, or 8 20-hour weeks per week in summers
