



PALOS VERDES PENINSULA LAND CONSERVANCY

EDUCATION INTERN ASSISTANT NATURALIST

DESCRIPTION

The Conservancy manages two nature centers that are equipped with interpretive displays. One is located at the George F Canyon Nature Center, a 36-acre preserve located in the City of Rolling Hills Estates featuring willow-riparian and coastal sage scrub habitats, and features live animals in the nature center along with a small gift shop. The second is located at the White Point Nature Preserve, a 102-acre preserve located in San Pedro, featuring grasslands and coastal sage scrub along with a small gift shop. When working in the interpretive center, naturalists will be in a position to tell the general public about the purpose and mission of the Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy.

An Assistant Naturalist will work under the direction of the Managing Naturalist to help in the interpretive center. Tasks will include working in the center during open hours, feeding native reptiles (at George F only), and helping with trail maintenance. Additionally, the Assistant Naturalist may assist with habitat restoration volunteer events.

REQUIREMENTS

- Currently enrolled in a college or university as a junior, senior, or graduate student
- Familiarity with local native plants and animals
- Ability to care for live native animals
- Ability to work independently
