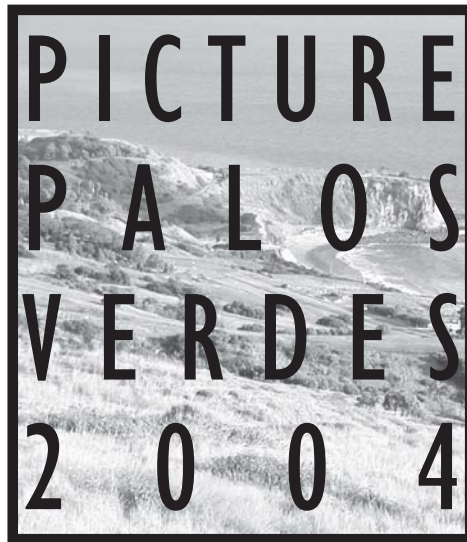
## Capture the Natural Beauty of the Palos Verdes Peninsula!

# Picture Palos Verdes Photo Contest Rules

1. All entries must be received at the PVPLC office address by September 22, 2004.
2. Photos must be taken on the Palos Verdes Peninsula and must show the natural beauty of the Palos Verdes Peninsula.
3. Photos may not contain recognizable people.
4. Entries may be color or black and white images, unmounted and unframed. Print size should be a minimum of 5" x 7" and maximum of 8-1/2" x 12". All entries will be judged based on the print submitted. Entries will also be displayed on the PVPLC website. If you wish to submit a digital version of your photo entry for website display, please submit via e-mail to:

5. Label all photos submissions with your name, address, telephone number, image title, category and location where the photo was taken.
6. Each contest entrant may submit up to three photos. All entries must be accompanied by the appropriate entry fee payment.
7. The Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy reserves the right to reproduce photographs in publications and electronic media.
8. Photo entries will normally not be returned. Non-winning photos may be picked up at the PVPLC office during normal business hours during the week of October 11.

## Category Descriptions

**Natural Landscapes:** Panoramas, sunsets, coastal or beach views, sky, clouds or other scenic views.

**Seascapes:** Coastal seascapes, harbor or tidepool views.

**Plants & Flowers:** Wild plants and flowers or those from your garden. *We encourage photos of California native plants. If you need help identifying CA native plants on the Peninsula, this website may be helpful: [sss.sccnps.org](http://sss.sccnps.org).*

**Wildlife:** Wild birds, animals, sealife, or insects found on the Peninsula. No domestic pets or livestock.

**Digitally Enhanced:** Be creative with your photo editing program and create a work of art from your photo.
